COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO HOLD “OFFICE HOURS” IN ROCHESTER PUBLIC LIBRARY, OCTOBER 6TH

Racine – Racine County Executive Bill McReynolds today announced the twenty-second in his series of “office hours” sessions in Racine County municipalities. On Wednesday, October 6, 2010, he will be available to meet county residents in the meeting room of the Rochester Public Library, 208 W. Spring Street, Rochester. The “office hours” session will run from 1:30 to 3:30 pm.

No appointments are necessary, and any county resident is free to meet with him on any county-related topic. Accompanying McReynolds will be County Board Supervisors Mike Dawson, Jeff Halbach, and Van Wanggaard, as well as several members of the County Executive’s staff. Other elected officials will attend, if their schedules permit.

McReynolds tries to hold office hours in one municipality each month; typically he will meet with local residents in the municipal building, if space is available and if local officials agree. Said McReynolds: “It’s important for all our people to know that county government is here to serve them and that it’s easily accessible to them. These meetings are a great opportunity to talk with our residents about the things that matter most to them.”

McReynolds thanked Rochester Village President Paul Beere and Village Clerk Betty Novy for making the visit possible.
