White Pine	(pinus strobus)	Fast	50' - 80'	Most	Sun to Shade	Long needles • Clusters of 5 • Windbreak/screening
Scotch Pine	(pinus sylvestris)	Medium	50' - 60'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	1" - 3" needles • Windbreak/screening • Drought tolerant
Red Pine	(pinus resinosa)	Medium	50' - 80'	Sandy	Sun / Part Shade	Long Needles • 4"- 6" in pairs
White Spruce	(picea glauca)	Medium	40' - 70'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Blue-Green Needles • Drought tolerant • Windbreak/screening
Colorado Spruce	(picea pungens)	Slow - Med.	60' - 90'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Short, green to silver-blue needles • Hardy
Norway Spruce	(picea abies)	Medium	60' - 90'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Pyramidal • Fastest growing spruce
Black Hills Spruce	(picea glauca densata)	Slow - Med.	60' - 65'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Pyramidal • Drought tolerant • Windbreak • "Christmas tree"
White Cedar	(thuja occidentalis)	Slow - Med.	30' - 50'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Scale-like flat leaves • Tolerates wet soil
Highbush Cranberry	(viburnum trilobum)	Fast	8' - 12'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	White flowers in spring • Bright red fruit in fall
Elderberry	(sambucus canadensis)	Fast	5' - 12'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	White flowers in late spring • Purple-black fruit in late summer
Rugosa Rose	(rosa, rugosa)	Fast	4' - 6'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Pink flowers from June-Sept • Upright plant
Butterfly Bush	(buddleia davidii)	Fast	10' - 15'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Arching • Attracts butterflies • Fragrant flowers all summer
Hybrid Poplar	(populus deltoides -nigra)	Very Fast	40' - 70'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Grows 5'-8' per year • Silver-green leaves • Prefers wet soils
White Oak	(quercus alba)	Slow - Med.	50' - 80'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Fall color purple-red • Wildlife planting • Acorns
Red Maple	(acer rubrum)	Med. - Fast	40' - 70'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Bright red flowers in spring • Fall colors yellow to scarlet
Hazelnut	(corylus americana)	Med. - Fast	10' -18'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Edible nuts (filberts) • Spring flowers
Sugar Maple	(acer saccharum)	Slow - Med.	60' - 80'	Most	Sun to Shade	Fall colors yellow to burnt orange • Shade tree
Red Oak	(quercus rubra)	Med. - Fast	60' - 90'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	Fall color red • Acorns • Long living tree
Whitespire Birch	(betula populifolia)	Medium	30' - 50'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	White barked • Resistant to birch borer • Narrow • Pyramidal
Dawn Redwood	(metasequoia glptostroboides)	Fast	70'-100'	Most	Full Sun	Fall color orange to red-brown • Ornamental
Dogwood	(cornus florida)	Fast	20'-40'	Most	Sun / Part Shade	White flowers in spring • Bright red berries in fall
Black Walnut	(juglans nigra)	Slow -Med.	50'-75'	Most	Sun/ Part Shade	Edible nuts • Grows in variety of soils

Definitions: **Growth Rate:** The rate of vertical increase in growth. *Slow = less than 12" per year, Medium = 13" to 24" per year, Fast = greater than 25" per year*
Age: All trees are seedlings (1 to 3 years old) (No transplants)

Wildflower Seed Mix	This mix consists of 24 species of wildflowers • Works best on clay loam to loam soils that are seasonably moist through well-drained <u>Includes:</u> <i>Bergamot</i> , <i>Black-eyed Susan</i> , <i>Blue Vervain</i> , <i>Canadian Milkvech</i> , <i>Cup Plant</i> , <i>Partridge Pea</i> , <i>Golden Alexander</i> , <i>New England Aster Ox-eye</i> , <i>Evening Primrose</i> , <i>Prairie Blazing Star</i> , <i>Purple Coneflower</i> , <i>Rattlesnake Master</i> , <i>Red Milkweed</i> , <i>Round-headed Bush Clover</i> , <i>Sawtooth Sunflower</i> , <i>Showy Sunflower</i> , <i>Smooth Blue Aster</i> , <i>Spiderwort</i> , <i>Stiff Goldenrod</i> , <i>Sweet Black-eyed Susan</i> , <i>White Wild Indigo</i> , & <i>Yellow Coneflower</i>

Other Items

Water Gel	Designed to increase moisture retention in plants • Mix with water, and gel retains moisture around roots at planting time • The gel will continue to attract and retain moisture for months • Each bag of water gel treats approximately 400 seedlings • <u>DO NOT</u> use in wet soils
Fertilizer	Gives nutrients in the biodegradable "tea bag" which is dropped in the planting hole and covered with 1 inch of soil Every 10-gram packet contains 10 essential nutrients and releases them over a 12-month period, when the seedlings need them most
