Qualifications: Candidates must be a U.S. Citizen, resident of the State of Wisconsin for at least one (1) year prior to making application, at least 21 years of age by the 3/10/12 written examination, have a High School diploma and have either a two year Associate degree **Or** a minimum of sixty (60) fully accredited college credits, have a valid driver's license from the state of residence, have not been convicted at any time or at any place of a felony, unless the judgment or conviction has been reversed or a complete pardon has been granted, or convictions related to the position of Deputy Sheriff, have binocular visual acuity correctable to 20/20, have height and weight relationship in proportion and establish residency in Racine County at the time of appointment as a deputy.
